

The influence of alcohol on college students

From the Recovery Commission

1,400 college students
between the ages of 18 and 24
die from alcohol-related unintentional injuries.

500,000 college students
are unintentionally injured under the influence of alcohol.

More than 600,000 students
are assaulted by another student who has been drinking.

More than 70,000 students
between 18 and 24 are victims of alcohol-related
sexual assault or date rape, and 100,000 report having been
too intoxicated to know if they consented to having sex.

2.1 million students
between 18 and 24 drove under the influence of alcohol last year.

31 percent of college students
met the criteria for a diagnosis of alcohol abuse
and 6 percent for a diagnosis of alcohol dependence
in the past 12 months
