Morning Presenter: Sister Patricia Michael Hauze

Sr. Patricia is a Solitary Religious in the Diocese of Bethlehem, having taken novice vows before The Rt. Rev. Paul V. Marshall, Bishop of the Diocese of Bethlehem on May 17, 2005. 'Sister Patty' also is a Spiritual Director, holding a certificate from Oasis Ministries. She has been a member of Trinity Church, Bethlehem for the past 21 years and has served as Parish Administrator at Trinity Church, Easton, since 2002. She is a member of the Trinity Bethlehem Prayer Beads Ministry and has written many of the prayers for use with Anglican Prayer Beads.

Afternoon Presenter: Kathy DeVito

Kathy has created a fabric replica of an ancient labyrinth-a circular walking path-used for contemplation. She will give an explanation of its history and significance. Each participant will have an opportunity to experience this form of walking meditation. Tom DeVito will lead participants in Taize chanting, enhancing everyone's contemplative experience.

Directions:

From the Allentown, Bethlehem area: Take 222 East to Rout 33 North to Route 512 North at the Wind Gap exit. Continue on Route 512 to the 5th traffic light when 512 makes a right hand turn, follow 512 through Pen Argyl when 512 makes a left hand turn, to the next traffic light. Stay in the left hand lane and continue straight onto E. main Street to the 5th left -turn left onto Nottle Street to the top of the hill and make a right hand turn onto Verona Ave. Follow Verona to the church.

From the Easton Area: Take 222 West and continue with the above directions.

From the Stroudsburg Area: Take 33 South and continue with the above directions.
